A beginner's method which recognizes the problems of the band student and takes him through them in interesting and logical steps. Register development has been given careful consideration so that although much of the material is unison, no instrument is taken out of a beginner's range. Clarinet players conquer the break, and cornet players work up to the higher tones, without the usual discouragements.

All material is melodious, with many songs included. Exercises are short and to the point, so that definite assignments may be made and many players heard individually in a few minutes. Scheduling is made easy, since any combination of instruments may be taught in the same class with satisfactory results.

The supplement of marches, etc., at the back of the book gives an ideal approach to the playing of regular band numbers and makes possible a concert, if anything like a full band is available.





#### POSITION AND FINGERING CHART



Study the picture at the left for correct position of lips and fingers. Also learn to use the fingering chart on this page. The row of circles or dots under the notes shows whether the regular finger keys should be open or closed. The letter "T" means the thumb key should be used. The letter "R" or "L" in connection with a number indicates what additional key should be used and whether the key is operated by a right or left hand finger. If two fingerings are shown for a note learn the one on the left first.







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









Legato-tongue softly, using the syllable "doo." There should be no pause between tones.

Can be used as a duet by the following instruments in any combination; cornet, Eb and Bb clarinets, D. S. al Fine Eb and Bb saxophone, trombone, and baritone.



The above number can be used as a duet or trio by the following instruments in any combination: cornet, Eb and Bb clarinets, Eb and Bb saxophones, trombone, baritone, and bassoon. With some groups an octave transposition of one or more parts may improve the effect. Use parts A and B for duet.



On the above number the cornet, Eb and Bb clarinets, Eb and Bb saxophones, trombone, baritone, and Eb horn can play together. For duet use upper notes of B part; for trio, lower notes.
